- Take Exit #26/West Rd. toward Ocoee Apopka Rd. - go 0.4 mi
- Turn left on West Rd. toward Ocoee Apopka Rd. - go 0.6 mi
- Turn left on Ocoee Apopka Rd. - go 0.6 mi
- Turn left on Fullers Cross Rd. - go 0.1 mi
